

**HAVERTHILL FARMERS' MARKET
RULES AND REGULATIONS
2010**

1. The market will be open from July 17th through October 30th.
2. The time of the market is 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM each Saturday.
3. It is the responsibility of each weekly participant to pay the Market Master before setting up or to pay for the entire season beforehand. Fees are outlined on the Vendor Application Form which is available at www.haverhillfarmersmarket.org.
4. Each seller must leave his/her area broom clean condition within ½ hour after selling stops. No food stuff, rubbish, or personal belongings of any sort shall remain after the market is closed.
5. All produce, plants, flowers, crafts, eggs, honey, cider, maple syrup, etc. must be locally grown and produced by the vendor registered at the market. Upon request of the Market Master, the vendor must show proof of growing or producing the products sold at the market. Purchased products may not be offered for sale. "Seller Made, Seller Grown" is our motto.
6. Baked goods, jams, jellies, and similarly processed foods may be sold if made locally. It is the vendor's responsibility to meet all of the requirements of the Health Department and obtain any necessary licenses. All vendors must be able to show evidence of compliance.
7. Prices will be determined by the seller; however, such prices must be posted in a conspicuous manner. Neither the Farmers' Market nor the City is responsible for any sales arrangements or warranty of any sort, expressed or implied, concerning products bought or sold.
8. Vendors must have their scales sealed by an official City or State Sealer of Weights and Measures.
9. The market will open at 9AM. The market will close at 1PM. All vendors must arrive early to set-up before the start of the market. All vendors must be ready to sell at the start of the market. If a vendor sells all of his/her products before the close of the market, he/she may leave with extreme caution and assistance from other vendors. This will be allowed at the discretion of the Market Master.
10. The Market Master shall be in charge of the Market operations such as parking, greeting new vendors and informing them of rules, fees, quality control, etc. Disputes will be settled by the designated Market Master, and such decisions will be final.
11. All regularly participating vendors are asked to assist the Market Master in monitoring the area around his/her truck for traffic congestion, new vendors who are not familiar with the market rules and fees, and other situations that may arise.
12. Absolutely, NO smoking near the Market. Any smoking must take place at least 15 feet away from the market. Please be considerate of the other vendors.
13. Any violation of these rules shall subject the violator to denial of further participation in the Farmers' Market.
